

The Dean of the Faculty of Economics and Administration announces

the Scholarship programme to support the study stay of international students enrolled in the fulltime form of studies at the Faculty of Economics and Administration – Social scholarship for covering the accommodation costs

Aim of the scholarship programme:

The aim of the scholarship programme is to lower the economic and social barriers preventing the international students from studying in the fulltime degree study programmes instructed in Czech and foreign (English) language.

The duration of the scholarship programme:

The scholarship programme is announced from 1.9.2015 until further notice.

Criteria for awarding the accommodation scholarship:

The scholarship is granted to students enrolled in some of the degree study programmes (bachelor, master of PhD. studies), fulltime form of study. The application can be submitted by any foreign student (except Slovak students), who is not awarded any other grant aimed on covering the accommodation costs.

The scholarship is granted based on the information provided [in the application](#) which must include:

- The reason for the Application
- Declaration that the applicant has not been awarded any other accommodation scholarship or financial support aimed on covering the accommodation costs (included in the online application)
- The applicant's tax return (or the tax return of applicant's parents, if they shared the household) from which the total annual income for the very last tax period is evident. This tax return must be duly certified by authorised tax institution of the relevant country. Original document or certified copy is to be submitted (possible to upload it in the application).

Evaluation criteria:

- Application completeness
- Applicant's income in comparison with the average income in the Czech Republic for the very last calendar year. Both compared incomes will be expressed in EUR or USD. For the conversion, the exchange rate valid in the last day of the period in consideration will be used. If the exchange rate is not known, the current exchange rate will be used. If this current exchange rate is not known, the last known exchange rate will be used.

Source of funding:

The source of funding is the scholarship fund of the Faculty.

The Dean of the Faculty decides who wins the scholarship based on the proposal made by the scholarship committee, which evaluates submitted applications.

Scholarship amount:

The basic amount of the scholarship is 43 000 CZK/calendar year.

The particular amounts awarded to individual applicants are determined according to the following rules:

Annual income of the applicant (in relation to the average income in the Czech Republic per cent)	Scholarship amount
Less than 30%	100% of the basic amount of the scholarship
30% - 50%	50% of the basic amount of the scholarship
More than 50%	0,-

The scholarship is awarded for the period

- a) of the first three semesters of bachelor or follow-up master degree studies
- b) of the first four semesters of doctoral studies. After the expiration of this period the doctoral students can apply for extension of the grant.

Payment of the scholarship:

The scholarship is paid out monthly in regular instalments.

The payment of the scholarship is terminated:

- After the max. length of support
- In case of study termination
- In case of study interruption
- In case the student is awarded another grant or financial support aimed on covering the accommodation costs.

Additional provisions:

The scholarship programme is announced in Czech and in English language, where in case of a dispute, the Czech version shall prevail.
