This study plan is only for students in their first year of studies. Other students have to enrol in courses according to their **control template in the Information system**.

## Study plan

The Study Plan is a list of courses that students must complete during their studies.

Students must obtain **at least 180 ECTS** to complete the bachelor's degree programme. At the same time, it is necessary to pay attention to the **Study and Examination Regulations** which say that in order to be able to enrol in the following semester, students must meet specific requirements. You can check these requirements in the Information System **here**.

During their studies, students have to pass the following types of courses:

### Compulsory courses

During their studies, students are obliged to complete all courses listed in the table below. It is not necessary to enrol in the course in the semester when it is listed below; however, please note that most of our courses are only taught in autumn/spring semester, so the possibility to enrol in them is usually only once per year (only in autumn or only in spring semester).

Students of this study programme are advised to enrol in the course **BPM\_MTH0 Mathematics 0** which will prepare them for the course **BPM\_MTHA Mathematics A** that is compulsory.

Before attending the final state examination at the end of their studies, students verify their completed courses using their **control template in the Information system**.

### Selective courses

During their studies, students must obtain **at least 40 credits** for selective courses in total.

### Physical education

During their studies, students are obliged to complete 2 ECTS from Physical education courses **whose list is available here**.

### Elective courses

Students enrol in elective courses up to the required minimum number of 180 ECTS. They may choose from courses offered by any faculty of the university.

At the same time, they have to make sure to search for courses in the correct semester and read the information about the course (**especially about the teaching language!!**) to make sure that the level and language of the course corresponds to their study level.

### Practical Training

As part of the elective courses, students can complete the **MPV\_PRAC Practical Training** course, where they can earn credits for working in an organization related to their study programme based on a pre-approved plan (must be approved by the training coordinator of the department). More information is available in the course description in the IS or at **the web of the faculty**.
