Miloš Fišar's lecture on *Reproducibility in Management Science* demonstrated his ability to manage a large-scale reproducibility project and effectively present its findings. The study, involving over 700 reviewers, assessed the reproducibility of nearly 500 *Management Science* articles before and after the journal's 2019 Data and Code Disclosure policy. Reproducibility improved significantly following the policy's introduction, though data accessibility remained a key limitation. The lecture was well-structured, providing a clear explanation of the research methodology and the significance of reproducibility in science. Conclusions were logically derived from the data analysis and convincingly argued. The applicant also demonstrated strong pedagogical skills by effectively addressing all questions raised during the discussion.
