

The measure of the Dean of the Faculty of Economics and Administration of Masaryk University No. 6/ 2020

Emergency measures concerning the risk of COVID-19 infection

(As amended from 12 October 2020)

Following Section 28, Paragraph 1 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., On Higher Education Institutions and Amendments to Other Acts (hereinafter referred to as the "Higher Education Institutions Act"), as amended, I issue the following measure:

Article 1

Introductory Provisions

- (1) This measure is based on Decision of the Rector No. 9/2020 *Emergency measures in response to the risk of COVID-19 infection* and the Methodological guideline of anti-epidemic measures and their implementation at MU. This document regulates procedures to prevent spread of COVID-19 infection at the Faculty of Economics and Administration MU.
- (2) General obligations to prevent spread of the infection are defined by the legislation of the Czech Republic, in particular, Act No. 258/2000 Coll., On the protection of public health and the amendment of some related acts.

Article 2

Escalation traffic light and operation of the Faculty

- (1) The traffic light is divided into four levels of risk, which are marked in white, green, yellow and red. White means zero or negligible risk, green means infection without community transmission in the area, yellow stands for incipient community transmission and red represents increased or persistent community transmission.
- (2) This traffic light is elaborated in more detail at the university level and sets procedures for individual levels of infection escalation in key areas of the university's activities. - (3) The level of risk corresponds to the current level set for Brno district, or the level set for MU. The Dean of the Faculty may announce a higher level of emergency in response to a higher level of local infection transmission.
- (4) A warning sign with the current colour of the traffic light is visibly placed at the entrance of the Faculty building. Information on the current risk level is also published on the faculty's website.
- (5) Compliance with the instructions of the traffic light system for individual areas of activity is obligatory. For activities which are not specified in the traffic light system, the instructions declared for the activity that is inherently closest in nature shall apply.
- (6) The work scheme of academic staff is based on instructions according to the current level of emergency and instructions of the Heads of departments.
- (7) The heads of the Dean's Office, Information and Communication Technologies Centre and Centre for Scientific Information decide on the work scheme of their departments depending on the current level of risk following the methodological guidelines. In the event of the third stage of emergency, they should define employees necessary to ensure the operation of the faculty. Other employees work from home.

Article 3

Notification obligation

- (1) Students are obliged to immediately report a positive test result for COVID-19 and quarantine through the IS MU.
- (2) Faculty employees are obliged to immediately report a positive test result for COVID-19, an epidemiologically significant contact, or suspicion of an infection, through the INET application COVID-19 Prevention.

Article 4
Final Provisions

- (1) I authorize the Faculty Secretary to interpret the individual provisions of this measure.
- (2) I authorize the Faculty Secretary to supervise compliance with this measure.
- (3) This Measure shall come into force on the date of its signing and shall take effect on the date of its publication.
