Study and Examination Regulations



- The most important document regulating your studies at MUNI both your rights and obligations
 - Get well acquainted with this document
 - A few notes:
 - Lectures are voluntary, seminars are always compulsory
 - Obtain at least 20 ECTS per semester (complete courses for at least 20 ECTS/semester)
 - 3 attempts to complete a course (1 regular attempt, 2 resits)
 - Repeated course: 1 regular attempt and 1 resit
 - Apply for improving a passing grade (B, C, D, E) via IS once per semester (only one course)
 - Absences:
 - one unexcused during the semester in each course (teachers may allow more, you will be informed in each course)
 - excuse must be done via IS MUNI within 5 working days of your absence







- Deliberate copying of another's text and passing it off as one's own, careless or inaccurate citation of the literature used, or failure to cite (even if unintentional) of any resource used.
- Constitutes a violation of core academic ethics and as such is prosecuted disciplinary offence
- Plagiarism is detected by an application implemented in the IS


How to avoid plagiarism?
